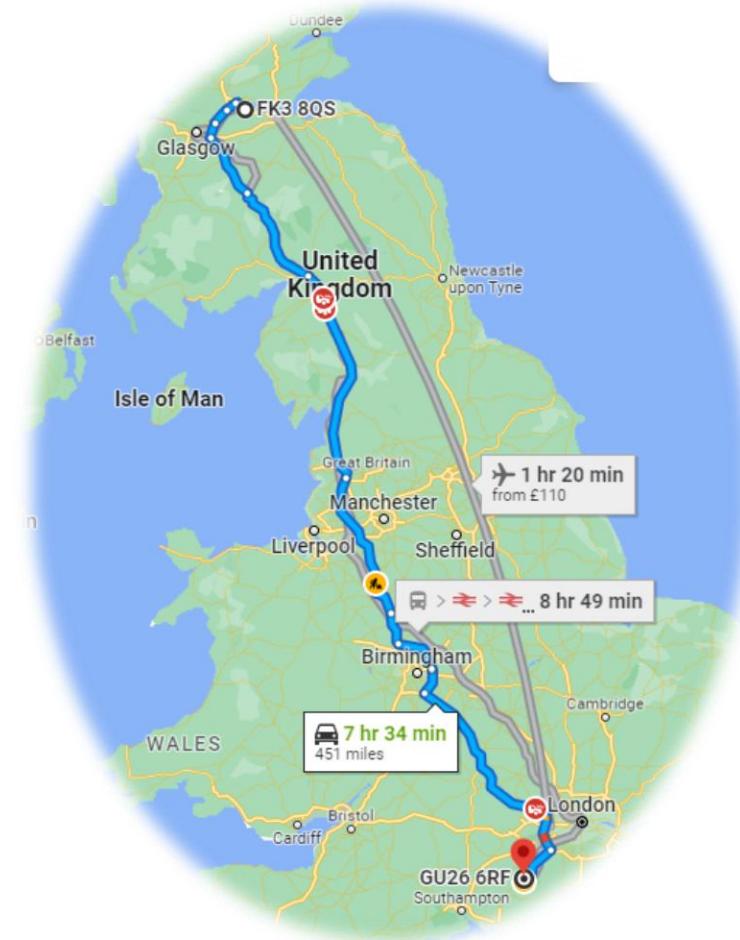

 - ▶ Evening activity



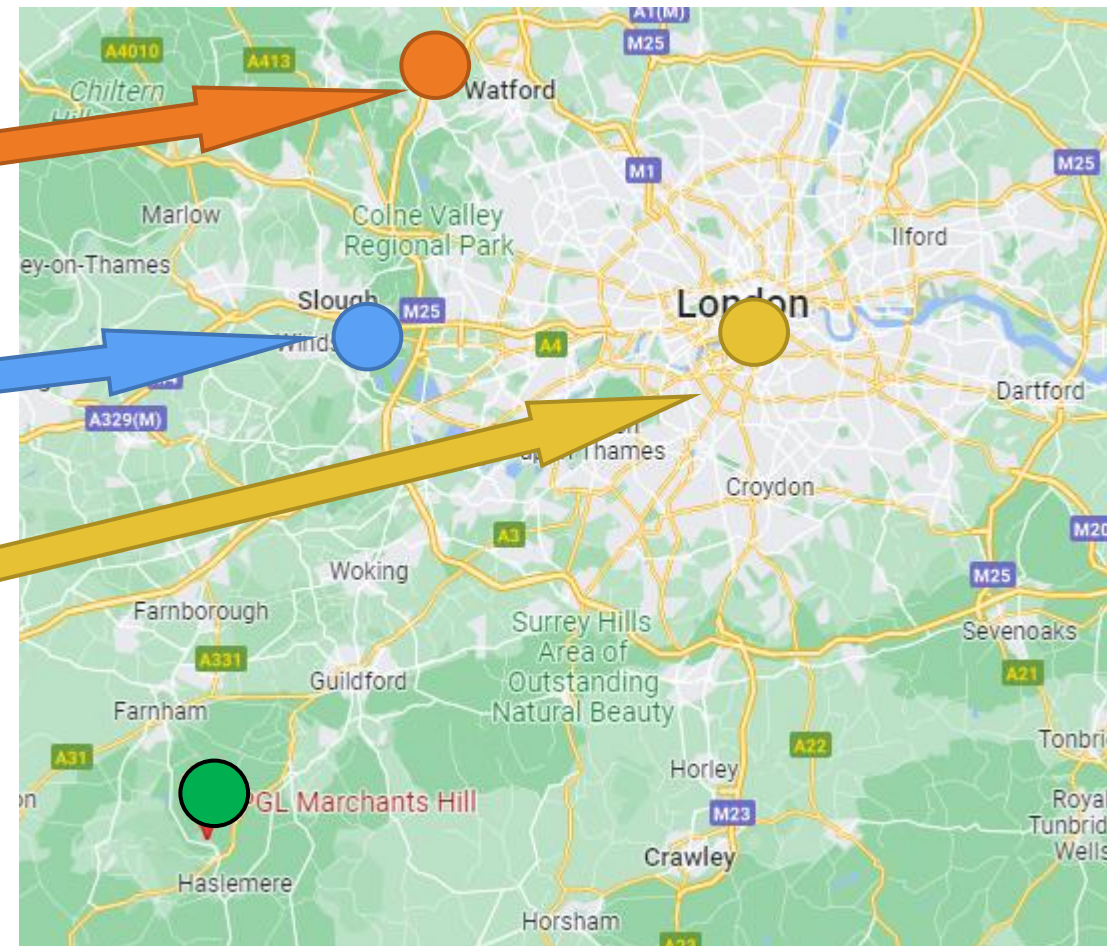

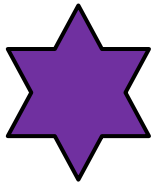


What should I pack?

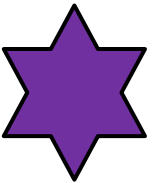

Please remember to pack **sun cream!**

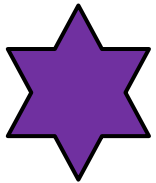


**Purple Beancross school jumpers or leavers hoodies will be worn when off-site from PGL.
This includes travelling to and from school.**

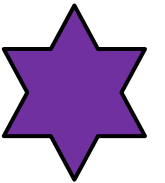


Quickly identifying our children -
